 B The Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand (Egat) plans to cut its staff numbers from 21,000 to 15,000 in 2023 under a business restructuring plan, said Witoon Kulcharoenwirat, chairman of the board, after a meeting yesterday. Witoon is also director-general of Energy Business Department of the Energy Ministry. The board also approved to reduce the number of deputy governors from 13 to 8 next years, after the retirements of three of them.
